Ash Wednesday and the Season of Lent

- 1. **Masses this week:** Next Wednesday is Ash Wednesday. Mass will be at <u>7am</u> and also at 9.15am to allow the St Joseph's school to mark the beginning of Lent.
- 2. Lenten fast and abstinence. Lent is a penitential season of prayer, self-denial and helping others. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence from meat. The law of fasting binds those from 18 to 60; the law of abstinence binds those who are 14 or older. This is the minimal legal requirement, but Lent is much more than a legal obligation; it is an invitation to join ourselves to Jesus in his forty days of self-denial in the desert. As we imitate our Saviour, we confront our own human weakness and remind ourselves of the brevity of life and our need for salvation which only comes through imitation of Christ.
- 3. The Law of Fast and Abstinence for Lent: These laws are on the noticeboard of the Church and copies are available from the table in the foyer.
- **4. Stations of the Cross**: We will be having the Stations of the Cross each Friday in Lent at 7pm in the Church. Come walk the journey in memory of Christ crucified.
- 5. Project Compassion promotes peace by pursuing justice. Please take home a Project Compassion box and/or set of envelopes and give generously this Lent. Your donations allow Caritas Australia, the Catholic Agency for International Aid and Development, to alleviate poverty and bring hope and justice to disadvantaged communities throughout the world. Collection boxes will be in the foyer.
- **6. Lenten groups:** The Lenten Program will commence during the first week of Lent. If you wish to participate in a group please contact Margaret in the office.
- 7. Palms: Last year's palms to be used for Ash Wednesday can be left in the foyer.
