Confirmation 2009: As you may have heard, Bishop Terry Brady is at present administering the Diocese of Wilcannia-Forbes and will be unable to confer the Sacrament of Confirmation on 27 September this year. However I am delighted to announce that Monsignor Kerry Bayada will once again coming to the Parish to confer the Sacrament.

Sacristy renovation update: We are still waiting for the formal construction certificate to be issued but we can now see clear signs of activity in the Church. The builders are making the necessary preparations for the major work to begin. There is now a temporary confessional where St Joseph's statue used to be (St Joseph will return eventually!) Behind Our Lady a small cubby-hole has been built for the temporary storage of the quite large sound system which is being relocated next Tuesday. The organ is now in its temporary home at the back of the Church. It will eventually be relocated in an alcove to be built on the Frederick St side of the Church, where the partition/barrier has been erected to allow the Church to be used while the work goes on. We have lost some of the Stations of the Cross here but these will be returned after the organ has been relocated. The temporary sacristy has been built in the Marian Hall and the original sacristy is now all but empty. The workers have also built a wall outside the sacristy to fence off the work from our school children. Some of the parishioners with good memories have told me that the organ is now where it used to be many years ago, and that the temporary sacristy is also where it was in the early years of the Church.

Monthly Healing Mass will be held on Fri 3 July at St Therese's Church, 15 Garrong Rd Lakemba. The celebrant will be Fr Stephen Monaghan. See notice board for details.
