Third Sunday of Easter: Laws, as we know do not of themselves create good living. The more laws there are, the greater the likelihood that they will be broken. The true approach to good conduct is through the right motivation. Christ condemned the Pharisees for their multiplication of petty regulations pointing out that what was far more important was the motives of peoples' hearts. There is much talk today about the permissive society. People say that we are living in lawless days when in fact we are living with so many laws that people are encouraged to find loopholes in them. What is needed is not more laws but a change of heart. Can people change their attitude? Christ said to his apostles before he returned to his Father "Thus it is written that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be preached in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem". This repentance, which means change of heart, should bring about a spiritual and moral renewal in all our lives. This change will be brought about through Christ. Love is the most powerful force in the world and bringing out what is best in people. Our faith should make us realise the overwhelming love of God for us as shown in the life, death and resurrection of Christ. If we really believe in the full sense of that word, that God did all this for us, a change of heart is inevitable in our lives.
