**FORGIVENESS:** Running through the whole of Scripture like a scarlet thread is forgiveness. The bible is the book of forgiveness. From its first pages to the end God is forgiving those who have sinned. In spite of all the infidelities of the people who came out of Egypt, even to the worshipping of a golden calf (the similitude of a beast that eats grass), God forgives them at the request of Moses.

Christ is the personification of forgiveness. God sent his Son into the world to take away its sins and show us the way to true sorrow.

In the Gospel we are given three very attractive parables of forgiveness. Christ is the good shepherd who hunts for the lost sheep to bring it back to the fold. We are given the beautiful comforting picture of the shepherd carrying the sheep on his shoulders symbolic of the love of Christ for the sinner. Christ too is the woman who searches for a lost coin and rejoices when she finds it. The Gospel ends with the most attractive parable of them all – the welcoming back home of the Prodigal son in spite of all his ingratitude. In all these parables there is a tremendous note of joy. The heart of Christ is filled with happiness when he wins over a sinner.

God knows us through and through. He knows our weaknesses and our selfish dispositions but at the same time he knows that we can rise to greatness and holiness with his help. The relationship of God to those whom he has made is indeed a great mystery, but then God's love is a mystery; but at least we can see how it reveals itself in kindness and mercy towards the greatest sinners. Everyone who has sinned will be welcomed back to his arms if, like the Prodigal Son, they are truly sorry for what they have done.
